### CLOTHING:

- Shirts (t-shirts and at least one long sleeve)
- A dressier outfit, for a dinner or a nicer night out (sundress, dress, blouse and pants, polo, and pants, etc.)
- Shorts
- Pair of pants/capris
- Jacket/rain jacket/poncho
- Undergarments
- Socks
- Loungewear/sleepwear
- Swimsuits/swim coverup

### SHOES:

- Walking/hiking shoes (sturdy)
- Sandals
- Water shoes
- Dress shoes (for dinner, night out)
- Flip flops

### MISCELLANEOUS:

- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- Hat/visor
- Toiletries
- Insect repellent
- Medication/first aid supplies
- Roll of toilet paper or pack of Kleenex (for remote restrooms)
- Backpack/beach and pool bag
- Binoculars (for wildlife sighting)
- Trekking poles (if hiking)
- Flashlight (for low light and remote areas, eco resorts, etc.)
